- Maintain confidentiality of institutional records, student performance, and sensitive information.
- Refrain from any form of harassment, discrimination, exploitation, or misconduct.

3. Student Engagement

- Foster an inclusive and student-centric learning environment.
- Provide academic guidance, career counseling, and mentorship to students.
- Encourage independent thinking, discipline, and ethical conduct among students.
- Avoid using professional relationships with students for personal or financial gain.

4. Institutional Commitment

- Abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of the Institution, University, and statutory bodies such as UGC/AICTE/State Government.
- Participate actively in academic, administrative, extension, and community engagement activities of the Institution.
- Contribute positively to the reputation, growth, and development of the Institution.
- Avoid activities that may harm the interests, dignity, or public image of the Institution.

6. General Discipline

- Maintain decorum, discipline, and professional conduct within the campus.
- Use institutional resources responsibly for academic and official purposes.
- Avoid political, commercial, or unauthorized activities within the Institution.
- Demonstrate exemplary behavior, both within and outside the campus, as representatives of the Institution.
