Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) Refusen Government P.4. College Israna (Panipat)

Haryana State Electronics Development Corporation Ltd. (HARTRON), Anaj Mandi, Israna (Panipat)

1. Preamble

- Advanced training in cybersecurity, artificial intelligence, data science, digital marketing, IoT, and related fields.

Entrepreneurship Development:

- Establishment of incubation support, mentoring, and guidance for startup ventures.
- Workshops on business planning, funding opportunities, and innovation.

Research & Innovation:

- Collaborative research projects in IT and digital governance.
- Support for student-led innovative projects.

Capacity Building:

- Faculty development programmes.
- · Digital literacy drives for students and staff.

4. Roles and Responsibilities

The College shall:

- 1. Provide necessary infrastructure such as classrooms, laboratories, computers, and internet connectivity for training programmes.
- 2. Nominate faculty members to coordinate the implementation of activities.
- 3. Mobilize students to participate actively in training and awareness programmes.
- 4. Ensure administrative support for smooth conduct of programmes.

HARTRON shall:

- Design training modules in consultation with experts and industry needs.
- 2. Provide experienced trainers and resource persons for skill development.
- 3. Conduct certification examinations and issue certificates to successful candidates.
- 4. Facilitate industry connect, internships, and possible placement opportunities.
- 5. Share relevant knowledge resources, digital content, and e-learning tools.

5. Benefits of the MoU

- Students will gain industry-ready skills and enhanced employment prospects.
- Faculty will be exposed to latest developments in IT and digital technologies.
- College will be recognized as a centre for IT skill development and innovation.
- HARTRON will expand its outreach and create a pool of skilled manpower in the State.

6. Implementation Mechanism

- A Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) shall be formed with representatives from both the College and HARTRON to oversee planning and execution.
- The JCC shall meet at least twice a year to review progress and plan future activities.
- Both parties shall jointly publicize the activities under this MoU.

7. Confidentiality

Both parties agree that any confidential information shared under this MoU shall not be disclosed to any third party without prior written consent, except as required by law.

8. Financial Arrangements

 The financial terms for each programme (if applicable) shall be decided on a case-to-case basis through mutual consent.

 Unless otherwise agreed, each party shall bear its own costs for the activities conducted under this MoU.

9. Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute or difference arising out of this MoU, the matter shall be resolved amicably through consultation and negotiation between the parties. If unresolved, the matter shall be referred to the competent authority in the Department of Higher Education, Haryana, whose decision shall be final and binding.

10. Validity & Termination

- This MoU shall remain valid for a period of three (03) years from the date of signing.
- Either party may terminate this MoU by giving a written notice of one month.
- · The ongoing activities at the time of termination shall be allowed to conclude smoothly.

11. Amendments

This MoU may be modified or amended by mutual consent in writing by both parties.
